



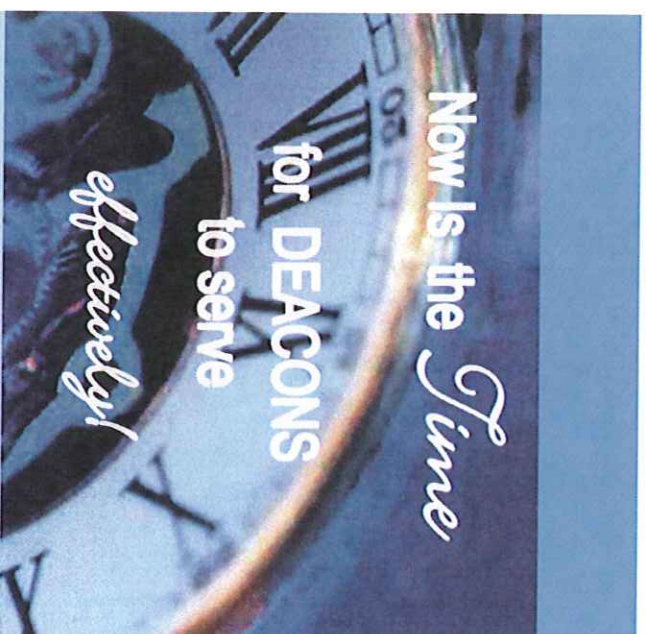

Speakers

Bob Sheffield has served as a pastoral ministry specialist in Pastoral Ministries at LifeWay Christian Resources, and as the National Consultant in Deacon Ministry for fourteen years. While at LifeWay, he led conferences for deacons, pastors, and staff in thirty-five of the Southern Baptist State Conventions.

He has served as a guest lecturer for classes in all of the Southern Baptist seminaries, the Canadian Southern Baptist Seminary, and Mid-America Baptist Seminary. He has also been a pastor of churches in Mississippi and Texas for 25 years. He is the author of *The Ministry of Baptist Deacons*.

Anthony H. Burdick joined the Department of Pastoral Care at the Baptist Memorial Hospital in Memphis in 1994 as a staff chaplain. He also worked as a bereavement coordinator for Baptist Trinity Hospice. He began serving as director of Hospice Pastoral Care for BMHCC in 1996. In 1997, he became director of Metro Pastoral Care. In 2006, he became system director of Pastoral Care.

He has edited and overseen the production of numerous written materials for the Department of Pastoral Care at Baptist Memorial Health Care. The most recent example is *God's Call to Serve*, a 108-page pocket-sized devotional and prayer book on servanthood.

Dr. Bill Northcott is Church-Minister Relations Specialist at the Tennessee Baptist Convention since 1998. Previously he served as Pastor of First Baptist Church, Covington, Tennessee.

He has led Leadership Conferences in Iowa, Montana, Indiana and Mississippi. He is the past President of the Southern Baptist Convention Fellowship of Church-Minister Relations.

Bill is author of *Pastor Search Resource Guide* and has trained over 75 search committees across the state of Tennessee.
